- Boy Scouts of America Youth Application
  - Select Crew for Unit Type and enter the number 0013 in the boxes on the top right
  - Complete Personal Information
  - Must be signed by both the parent and the youth if under the age of 18.
- West Shore Bureau of Fire Application
  - Complete all fields including previous training and experience
  - Include 3 references
  - Application must be signed by a parent and youth if under the age of 18.
